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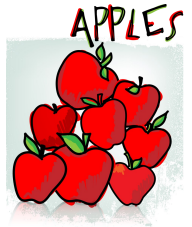
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


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
Apple Science



Make sure you have the materials you need: an apple, a sharp knife {for your grown-up to use}, a plate, a lemon, and this lab sheet.




Draw your apple — what does it look like? Make sure you add a blend of colors.



Prediction	Actual Number

Predict how many seeds your apple will have, and ask your grown-up helper to cut it in half across the middle. Then count them.




Think about what happens to apples when they are left out. Tell your grown up what you know, and what you think might happen.

Put your two apple halves on a paper plate. Label them #1 and #2. Brush #1 with lemon juice. Leave #2 alone.

Draw what your apple halves look like in the top box in the apple to the right.

Go play for 3-4 hours and then come back and check your apples and draw what they look like after the time has passed.
